Report

Training programme on Preservation and maintenance of crude drugs was organised at Pydah college of Pharmacy, Kakinada on 12-11-2018. A. Venkateswara Rao has discussed importance of crude drugs and storage. He told that the crude drugs should be stored in tight containers after the usage. Small quantities of crude drugs could be readily stored in air-tight, moisture proof and light proof containers such as tin, cans, covered metal tins, or amber glass containers. The excessive moisture facilitates enzymatic reactions resulting in the decomposition of active constituents, e.g. digitalis leaves and wild cherry bark. Gentian and ergot receive mould infestation due to excessive moisture.
